Cost of Attendance

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is Barbers Trade School’s estimate of the total student cost for participation in a program. Note that all students are responsible for food, housing, transportation, and other personal living expenses for the duration of a program.

The COA is used to calculate federal financial aid and student loan limits. It also provides enrolled students with the financial information needed to project budgets. Students who have dependent children and require childcare services while attending class at Barbers Trade School may be eligible to add that expense to the COA. Students who borrow federal funds under the Federal Direct or PLUS loan programs may request that origination fees be added to the COA figures.
